KAH100 Qualified Work Placement within the Humanities, 30 credits*

***60 credits represent a full academic year.**

Course Information

This course, where the students spend most of the semester at their Internship Placement, is given at the University of Gothenburg. The entry requirements are 150 credits (i.e. two and a half year of higher education) including a Bachelor's thesis within the field of the Humanities. In other words the student is well prepared for a qualified work assignment that may consist of everything from reports, evaluations, analysis, surveys, events, information work, translation assignments, excavations, linguistic evaluation, museum jobs and cultural activities in general.

A host Supervisor should be appointed for the student/intern at their internship placement. This supervisor is required to discuss and develop an elementary Internship Placement Plan for the assigned work, together with the student/intern. This plan should focus on content of work assignments, specifying the objectives and the planning on how to achieve these. Work assignments should be relevant in relation to the course purpose and advanced in character. The student/intern will bring a template for such an Internship Placement Plan. When the plan has been formulated, the plan is to be submitted for approval to the Course Coordinator Marita Rhedin. The plan can be revised, but preferably it is complete when the internship begins.

The placement period lasts from **week 35 (August 28) 2023 to week 52 (December 29) 2023** and during this time the student/intern will follow your standard working hours if nothing else is stipulated. *We would however like the student to get about 5 hours a week to read course literature and participate in mandatory online discussions for the course.*

During the placement period the student/intern is required to write a report and at the end of the internship this report should be presented, followed by comments and discussion during a seminar. In the report the student/intern will give examples on and describe their assignments and how these provide opportunities for the student/intern to acquire experience in their field, i.e. to integrate their theoretical knowledge gained while studying the field of the Humanities with a specific area of work. The student should also attach such an example to the report.

During the placement period the student will be covered by the The Swedish State's Insurance for higher education abroad.
